

## New German Act on Corporate Due Diligence Obligations in Supply Chains

The law will enter into force on 1 January 2023.

SAMSON AKTIENGESELLSCHAFT has successfully put in place the necessary measures as part of a project run during the 2022 business year to detect, prevent and stop any negative effects that a company's business activities have on human rights and the environment. As of 1 January 2023, staff and external parties will have the opportunity to report violations to the dda Due Diligence in Supply Chains team.
